



Oakridge Calgary Co-op Re-opens After Product Tampering Incident

January 18, 2010, Calgary, Alberta – Earlier today, Calgary Co-op temporarily closed its Oakridge Centre located on Southland Drive and 24th Street SW, when it found evidence of tampering in some of its bulk bakery, bulk foods and cheese products. Police and health authorities were immediately notified and an investigation began that included an inspection of products throughout the store.

Calgary Co-op has now completed its inspection, has removed all bulk items and issued a voluntary recall on these products as a precautionary measure. The store is now open.

Food safety is our top priority and we want to assure our customers that we are taking all steps necessary to ensure the products we sell are safe. Police continue to investigate.

Customers who may have purchased bulk bakery products, bulk food items or cheese products can return these products to the Calgary Co-op Oakridge Centre for a full refund.

This recall affects products purchased from the Oakridge Centre only.
