## Calgary Flames Tickets Draw

**September 2011 through April 2012**

### **Draw Rules and Regulations**

The Calgary Flames ticket sale draw will be held at all Calgary Co-op food centres during the 2011 - 2012 Calgary Flames pre-season and regular hockey season. Note: The ticket sale contest may be extended if the Calgary Flames make the playoffs.

Each Calgary Co-op food centre will have up to five pairs of tickets for every pre-season and regular season Calgary Flames home game.

Customers can participate in the Calgary Co-op draws for a chance to purchase two tickets (one pair) of Calgary Flames tickets per random draw per home. Tickets must only be sold in pairs (no single ticket sales are permitted).

A draw will be made by the store manager at each Calgary Co-op food centre three days before the date of the home game for which the ticket contest is being held.

Customers must be age 18 years or over to enter the random draws.

To enter, a customer must line up at a Calgary Co-op customer service office starting at 7:00 p.m. on the date of the draw that they want to enter. Each customer will receive one numbered ticket for that day's draw only. The numbered ticket is good only for that specific draw date only and will not be retained by Calgary Co-op for any future ticket draws.

Chances of winning are based on the number of entries received at each location on each draw date.

The draw will take place at 7:15 p.m. Up to five winning numbered entry tickets will be drawn. The winners of the draw must be present to win. The winners of the draw may purchase two tickets for seats in the Coca-Cola Real Fan Zone for the price of \$34.99 each plus GST. Following the draw, all ticket entry forms received for that date's draw will be destroyed by Calgary Co-op.

Customers whose numbered tickets are drawn and who choose to purchase a pair of tickets at the price stated, must immediately pay for the tickets. Tickets must be for personal use only and not for re-sale. The winner assumes all responsibility and liability for the use of the tickets they purchase.

If all of the tickets are not sold in the draw due to a lack of entries, Calgary Co-op may offer to sell additional sets of tickets to the customers who are in attendance for the draw. Tickets must be sold in sets of two only.

Prize must be accepted as offered. No cash value. No returns will be accepted and no refunds will be provided.

Calgary Co-op reserves the right to withdraw this offer, cancel the draw or amend the rules at any time.

All decisions made by Calgary Co-op in respect to the draws are final.
